It was found by Mr. Kilpatrick, Counsel of the Revenue Committee, and I appreciate his eagle eye in spotting, again, one of my mistakes. With that, I would like to have the bill returned for purposes of adoption of this technical change. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Hall. Any discussion on the motion to return? Seeing none, Senator Hall. He waives closing. The question is to return to Select File for specific amendment LB 300. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill is returned to Select File. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, I would just move adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Hall, any close, anything further? The question is the adoption of the Hall amendment to LB 300. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to advance LB 300 to E & R.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Hall. Any discussion on the advancement of the bill? Seeing none, the question is the advancement of LB 300 to E & R Engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced.
