SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Janssen, there are no further lights on. Do you have a closing? Question is, shall LB 581 be returned to Select File? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is returned. Senator Janssen, on your motion.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I almost...I think I have explained it thoroughly enough on returning it to Select File. The only thing I can say is that this is correcting what the intent of the Legislature was in 1993 when the bill was passed and hope for your approval of the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: There are no further lights on. I'm assuming that will be the closing. We will proceed to vote. All in favor of the Janssen amendment vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I would move to advance LB 581 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Final Reading is completed. We're moving to Select File, LB 712, Mr. Clerk.
