SENATOR MATZKE: I am afraid I will have to request a call of the house.

SENATOR CROSBY: There has been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no.

SENATOR MATZKE: And I will accept call-in votes.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

CLERK: Senator Pirsch voting...you had voted yes, Senator.

CLERK: I don't have enough votes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Matzke is accepting call-in votes on his amendment to the Stuhr amendment.

CLERK: Senator Maurstad voting yes. Senator Witek voting yes. Senator Janssen voting yes.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Matzke's amendment to Senator Stuhr's amendment.
