

issues that would...the medical benefits that would be provided at the county level, that if an individual does not meet those requirements or has exhausted their benefit period with regard to the state, then the same holds true at the county level. I believe it is a consistency argument that the amendment brings to you and provides that what's good for the state clearly ought to be good for the counties. I would urge its adoption.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, I know some of you all just couldn't wait to hear chapter two of what I have to say, and I couldn't wait to tell you. You are going to get rid of all those little children because in this bill there is a provision to punish entire families if the adult does not cooperate in a way that the caseworker thinks. So you don't just deny the benefit to the adults, you deny the benefit to the children too. So that's why I say we get all these little brats involved. So the little children, they die off, these old people die off, but then you are going to have some people who will not go quietly and gently into that good night of oblivion. Let's assume, before I get to them, that you have a few of these little brats who manage to escape, because even when the Nazis were trying to kill off an entire race of people, they were not successful. So some of them may live to grow up, and I wonder what they will become when they have had to live by their wits, without any assistance, no place to go. We are creating an army of revolutionaries. They will rob. They will pillage. Their little hands will always be near to their knife, their gun, their club, or their brick, and they will say there is no way you are going to be full and I am going to be empty. I am going to walk by a restaurant and see all these people in there eating, and I am hungry, my brothers and sisters are hungry, or my children are hungry. I am going to walk by your grocery store and all of that to eat is in there and I can't be fed and I can't feed my children, and I am going to let you eat? No, no. We are going to all have it together or none of us are going to have it. But on the other hand, when you get away from those children, and you have some of these people who are thrown out there, as they surely will be, and based on the attitude of most of the senators, they should be, then I think it is a situation that we should anticipate the results of. If you can turn your eyes away from what it is we are talking about, just for a moment, and not fall into that sham sensitivity and
