CLERK: 20 ayes, . nays to go under call.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. We are voting on Senator Beutler's amendment to the committee amendments and Senator Beutler has indicated he will accept call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Will voting yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Abboud, Senator Bohlke, Senator Bernard-Stevens, would you like to check in. Senator Brashear, Senator Lindsay, Senator Coordsen. Senator Schimek, would you like to check in. Senator Schrock, Senator Engel, Senator Jensen, Senator Jones.

CLERK: Senator Brashear voting yes. Senator Pedersen voting yes. Senator Lindsay voting yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Record, Mr. Clerk, and a record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1597 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 3 nays on the amendment, Madam President.
