CLERK: Excuse me, Mr. President. The next amendment I have is by Senators Warner and Bromm. (FA137 appears on page 1601 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely, you're authorized to handle this amendment?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes. Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I'm having copies run of this right now, but both Senator Warner and Senator Bromm came to Senator Bohlke and I, and I'll yield time to Senator Bohlke here in a second, to ask us, if you recall on the amendment that Senator Witek had on health insurance, there was a concern. Senator Warner wanted to change that to health care and Senator Bromm wanted to involve the Legislature as well as the Governor, so the amendment that they have drafted, this is an amendment from Senator Warner and Senator Bromm and it is one that I and Senator Bohlke agreed to, clarifies that language about the health care study and it would amend Section 14 of the Standing Committee amendment and read as follows. On lines 16, 18, 23, and 24 after the word "health", strike "insurance" and insert "care through insurance or other methods". Okay, so now instead of looking at access to health insurance, we'll be looking at access to health care through insurance or other methods, a little more flexibility. And where we talked about the Governor shall look into this issue, on page 17, after "Governor", strike "should" and insert "together with the Legislature shall", so it's the Governor and the Legislature. I think it clarifies what we talked about and I would ask for support for the amendment and give the rest of my time to Senator Bohlke.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Senator Wesely. I, too, support the amendment and I think, as Senator Warner indicated earlier, that the term "care" will increase the comfort level of a number of people rather than the term "insurance", and I think it's best to involve the Legislature with the Governor in that decision, therefore, I support the amendment.
