SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bernard-Stevens, to close.

I appreciate the debate on the amendment, I appreciate Senator Matzke's and Stuhr's support of the amendment to the amendment. This amendment simply strikes the words "and obtain custody" in the places in the bill that refers to the registry and I would appreciate its adoption.
