You take his license of any kind and variety because he's a rat and will not take care of his children. Then you have a man who says I want my child and you say, he shall not have his child because he's a rat. He's a rat if he won't take care of the child, he's a rat if he wants the child. That's what I'm saying that shows me the hypocrisy and dishonesty in this whole thing. I'm not talking about Senator Matzke's effort in the bill to give the father notice and an opportunity to vindicate his rights. That's not what I am talking about. I'm talking about the thing that I've been hammering and I've hammered it because I'm going to put an amendment up there and I believe because nobody wants to discuss it. I'll run out of time speaking my allotted numbers of time before I can fully put on the record what it is I'm trying to say.

SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So either the man is a rat because he won't take care of his children or he's a rat because he wants a child, but he can't be a rat in both instances. But that's the attitude that is being brooded about this morning. And Senator...well, Senator Schimek is not here. I'm going to ask her directly when she comes back and my amendment is before us, if she's on the floor, if she is saying that she wants to elevate these commercial interests above the interest of a mother who has a second thought and wants to reclaim her child, that holy, sacred thing which we refer to when we're talking about abortion which God has seen fit to place within her womb and give her temporary stewardship over. Well all that goes out the window when the money of the agencies come in, doesn't it?
