SPEAKER WITHEM: It will be deemed as having been withdrawn and then refiled so it will be at the bottom of the list. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bromm would move to amend with AM1551. (See page 1570 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Mr. Speaker, I'm going to pull that amendment. The next one takes care of what this one was going to do.

SPEAKER WITHEM: AM1551 is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Jensen. AM1586, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Jensen.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, and members of the body, this amendment, I think, was passed out earlier in the morning. It is found on page 1, line 8. We strike the word...or we strike "obtain" and insert "inform the biological father of his right to execute". And in lines 10 and 11, strike "from the biological father", and on page 2, line 24, strike "obtain" and insert "inform the biological father of his right to execute", and in line 26, from "from" and then to "fathers". This is somewhat technical but I think it does clean up the language of the bill. This was done in cooperation also with Senator Bromm and I would be glad to answer any questions, either myself or directed to him. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Chambers, on the Jensen amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I would like to ask Senator Jensen a question about the form of his amendment.
