SENATOR WESELY: Better ask for a call of the house, please.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their desks. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Wesely, you'll accept call-in votes? The question before you is the adoption of the Wesely amendment to LB 837. We are accepting call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Schimek voting yes. Senator Fisher voting yes. Senator Landis voting yes. Senator Lindsay voting yes. Senator Robinson voting yes. Senator Pedersen voting yes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Wesely amendment is adopted. Senator Kristensen would like to announce that the following guests are visiting the Legislature, Danny and Jane Smith are here from Omaha.
