CLERK: Senator Kristensen voting yes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Waiting for Senator Withem. We are accepting call-in votes. There has been a request for a roll call vote. We are waiting on Senator Withem. There has been a request for a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1634 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 9 nays on the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Bohlke amendment is adopted. Is there anything further on the Wesely amendment? I raise the call.

CLERK: Nothing further pending to Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: We return now to a discussion on the Wesely amendment. Any further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Wesely, do you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR WESELY: Well, the amendment is a little less than I had hoped for, but I'd still ask for its adoption. Let me tell you that I'm very disappointed in that last vote and I understand why some of you did what you did, but as we try to contain costs and make some hard choices, keep in mind that this was a chance we had to save money in a significant way, but nevertheless, I'd move for adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Wesely. The question before you is the adoption of the Wesely amendment to LB 406. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Wesely amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Dierks would move to amend the bill.
