

right, there's consent calendar coming up elsewhere as the Speaker is trying to work with the Legislature, if we get a quorum, at eight-thirty in the morning, to try some of these things. There's lots of places still if this bill is truly noncontroversial and needs to be done. I think the Chair's ruling is consistent, it may be a good bill but we need to be true to our rules at this particular point and I would ask that the Chair at least not be overridden. But if the Chair is overridden, that's fine, it probably is a good bill, but I think it's going to set a process going that we don't want to have necessarily started today, but it certainly will continue in the next week I can assure you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Any further discussion on the motion to overrule the Chair? Senator Wesely, to close?

SENATOR WESELY: I'm going to prevail to Senator Will's will and withdraw my motion to overrule and allow his motion to take the floor.

PRESIDENT ROBAK. Thank you. The motion is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Will would move to suspend Rule 7, Section 3(d) to permit consideration of AM1346.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. This is simply a motion to suspend the germaneness rule to allow consideration of this amendment. If it's truly noncontroversial, and there is a question about germaneness, I think this is a more straightforward way to take this up would be simply to suspend the rule that is causing Senator Bernard-Stevens some concern, and that is within the rules obviously for us to do that, we can suspend our own rules, we can allow an amendment such as this to be considered. And I think if Senator Wesely can make the case that it's noncontroversial, that it's substantially related to the purposes of this bill, that we might as well suspend the germaneness rule and allow the consideration of this amendment.
