CLERK:      26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Dierks' amendment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: The amendment is agreed to. Anything else on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: This is difficult. Yes, Mr. President, I move to advance LB 718 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Is there any discussion? The Chair seeing no discussion, all those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. It appears the ayes have it, the bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kristensen would like to print amendments to LB 490 and to LB 696; and Senator McKenzie would like to print amendments to LB 629. (Journal also shows that Senator Hall had amendments printed to LB 589. See pages 1644-46 of the Legislative Journal.)
