The genuine belief that another has a point of view from which you can learn, from which we can profit and that listening is more valuable than speaking and he had that, although I'm going to guess he was at least 60 at that point, and I was almost half his age at the time. I was tremendously flattered by that and yet there was no intention to flatter. It was a genuine outlook in which Joe R. was seeking information, was asking other people and was genuinely interested in what they had to say without any pretense, without any fabrication, without any manipulation. It was a very genuine quality and I remember that time as being like all the others that I spent with Joe R. They were a handful in number, but they all were informed by those qualities and I find them remarkable. He is well worth remembering today.
