

insurance division about frauds that they're aware of or they suspect. So those general elements are in the bill. Now these amendments are relatively technical. One changes doctor records to medical records because that's the better term. One includes entity as well as person, although persons do, of course, include individuals and corporations. Entity refers to other kinds of business organizations that may not qualify for the term "person". It corrects an erroneous internal reference and it inserts language in the bill to explicitly recognize the current fraud enforcement activities of the Nebraska Workers' Comp Court, and they already do this kind of work. I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Landis. Is there any discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Landis, do you wish to close on the committee amendments?

SENATOR LANDIS: I'll waive closing, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 385. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.
