

to terminate, not proceed any further. Is there inability to continue to collect federal match, or is it simply the situation is such that we can't get the cooperation from the hospitals involved, or what is the termination about discontinuing that transfer?

SENATOR WARNER: You mean beyond this year?

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR WARNER: Well I had a bill to do that, but it sits down in committee. This bill has no effect on that, you understand. This bill, all it will do, because this intergovernmental transfer was only for the one year in any event. And all this bill does now, as it will...with this amendment, is changes the final payment date from April 30th to June 15th of that 6.5 million. Your question wouldn't be to the bill but to the bill that we had that I introduced to continue it. For example, the opposition was obviously numerous and whatever reason you could think of, that would be one of them.

SENATOR WESELY: (Laugh.) I'll talk to you later.

SENATOR WARNER: Yeah.

SENATOR WESELY: But I understand what you're saying. Thank you very much.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Any further discussion on the Warner amendment? Seeing none, Senator Warner. He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 693. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please. Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The Warner amendment is adopted.

ASSISTANT CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Warner, on the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, I move the bill be advanced.
