

fashion. If that's the case then maybe we can start the road towards crafting that. But, at least for this particular purpose, this is not a facetious amendment, it's an amendment that simply recognizes where those services are going to be delivered. And those services are not going to be delivered here in Lancaster nor in Douglas or Sarpy, some of those areas. With the amount of money we're given, let's at least get the lawyers out to the areas where they are going to be. I'd urge the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. The question before the body now then is the adoption of the Lindsay amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 4 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: House is under call. Members, please return to the Chamber and record their presence. Unauthorized parties leave the floor. Senator Matzke, Senator Coordsen, return to the Chamber, please, the house is under call. Senator Schrock, Senator Elmer, Senator Wesely. Senator Janssen, Senator Jensen, Senator Jones, Senator Landis. Senator Lindsay, this is your amendment, how do you want us to proceed? Mr. Clerk, who are we waiting for? Senator Schrock and Senator Matzke, you're wanted on the floor. Senator Schrock, if you'd check in, please. Senator Matzke is here. Call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1676-77 of the Legislative Journal.) 8 ayes, 23 nays on the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is not adopted. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, we'll go to Item 6 for Senator Wehrbein's motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wehrbein would move to suspend Rule 3, Section 4, and Rule 6, Sections 1 and 2, to place LB 889 directly on General File.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members, this is about the SOS situation. And for those of you that may not know at this
