

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The committee amendments are adopted. Theoretically, Senator Kristensen, you would have the opportunity to open on your bill.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Mr. Speaker, I believe it wise to waive. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. We are now debating the advancement of LB 646. There are amendments to the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Lindsay would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: What amendment is that, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Page 6, Senator, you strike subsections 2, 3, 4, 8 and 9. On pages 8 and 9, you strike subsections (4), (5), (6), (7), (8) and (9) of AM903, which I...

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yeah, that, I believe, would be similar to Senator Hall's amendment, so I would withdraw that.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend, Mr. President, with AM1364.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Withem, members of the Legislature, I've gathered up all my amendments and given them to Senator Kristensen and asked him to look at them with a view to some changes on Select File. And with that, I would withdraw that amendment and withdraw any other amendments I have up there.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Beutler amendments are withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Lindsay and Hall would move to indefinitely postpone LB 646.
