If the bill is...if it's one that you think is going to fail to advance at some stage or is going to get killed or laid over, or whatever, at some other stage and you're not comfortable that it's ever going to get to a position where you're going to be supporting it, we ought to look at indefinitely postponing it at this point rather than eating up the time to write the bill on the floor, I guess, or get it in a position where we are comfortable doing it. At least with the path we've had it down for me, personally, and again it's just my personal views, but for me, personally, I just...I don't see how it is going to get to that shape certainly given the track record that we have as far as what we've done with amendments so far. Given that, I...for me, it's not going to get to that position. I would...I will be voting to IPP the bill and would hope you would join me.
