

SPEAKER WITHEM: To indefinitely postpone a bill on General File, the vote required is a simple majority.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: A simple majority of those voting?

SPEAKER WITHEM: A simple majority is defined as a majority of those voting. A majority of those voting will constitute a favorable vote on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Abboud, we're waiting for Senator Abboud. Senator Lindsay, I believe it was your call of the house, and I don't recall if you gave instructions as to how to proceed? We'll take a roll call in regular order when Senator Abboud is located. Proceed, Mr. Clerk. The motion before the body is the indefinite postponement of LB 646.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1688 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 21 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The motion to indefinitely postpone fails. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Nothing further on the bill. Question before the body now then is the advancement of LB 646. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. President, members of the body, I have some questions for Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Kristensen, will you respond?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Sure.

SENATOR ROBINSON: First question, how much more is this bill going to cost?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator, we have talked about an A bill of \$500,000.
