SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. President, could we have a call of the house? And I would like to have a reverse roll call vote, please.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Dierks. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: The house is under call. Will members please return to the Chamber and record their presence. All members on the floor please return to your seats and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senators Matzke, Maurstad and McKenzie. Senator Pirsch, if you would record. Thank you. Senator Schellpeper, Senator Schimek, if you would record your presence. Thank you very much. Senator Vrtiska, Hartnett and Wickersham. The house is under call. Senator Hartnett, the house is under call. Senator Dierks, when Senator Hartnett is here, the request is for a roll call in reverse order. Is that correct? Thank you very much. Madam Sergeant-at-Arms, has Senator Hartnett been located? He's on his way? Thank you. Senator Hartnett is here. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll. The question is the adoption of the Dierks amendment to LB 455.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken in reverse order. See pages 1753-54 of the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 17 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR HALL: The amendment fails. The next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk. Items for the record, and the call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 251, LB 396, LB 438, LB 438A, LB 488, LB 563, LB 563A as correctly engrossed.
