

with the idea of doing this. He had the amendment drafted. We used his form. This is meant to be a time saving move, not a time consuming move. I'd appreciate if you don't want to bracket the bill, my appreciation would be just vote no on the motion, don't bracket it and continue on, but my sense from listening to the debate is what we have is a substantive agreement around a concept and we don't have the specific language. And I think it would be pointless, I know there is some argument here as to whether we ought to advance the bill and bring it back or whether we ought to slow it down here. Let me tell you, I'm working on Monday's agenda, my intention on Monday is Monday morning will be time for Select File, that this bill will be the first one up on Monday morning. What this motion would let us do is use the remaining hour and forty-five minutes to get onto some other legislation instead of milling around here on the floor trying to draft language. It would give people an opportunity over the weekend to look at the language and have these sorts of discussions that...you know I'm not sensing a huge policy debate, what I'm hearing is the difficulty of getting language written properly. That's the purpose for the bracket motion and I would urge your support. As a matter of fact, let me see if we can do this through unanimous consent.

SENATOR LINDSAY: There has been a request that LB 337 be bracketed until Monday. Is there objection? It is so ordered. Mr. Clerk, the next bill.

CLERK: Mr. Speaker, I assume 337A as well, bracket 337A.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yeah, definitely would. As a matter of fact, I would just say that that would not be on the agenda because it has to follow the substantive bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 658 on Select File. The first item I have are Enrollment and Review amendments.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Senator Maurstad. Senator Pirsch, would you like to move the E & R amendments to your bill.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Yes, I move the E & R amendments to LB 658 be adopted.
