SENATOR LINDSAY: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 658. All in favor say aye. Opposed. Motion carries, the amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Witek would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator Pirsch would have the option to lay the bill over if she was so inclined.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Senator Witek. Senator Pirsch, you would have the right to lay that over. Would you like to take it up or lay it over?

SENATOR PIRSCH: I had assumed she was going to withdraw that.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Is Senator Witek present? She is coming in now. Senator Witek, on your motion to indefinitely postpone LB 658.

SENATOR WITEK: Senator, I am pulling that motion.

SENATOR LINDSAY: It is withdrawn. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pedersen would move to amend. Senator, AM1015. (See page 1192 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LINDSAY: Senator Pedersen.

SENATOR PEDERSEN: Senator Lindsay and members of the Legislature, AM1015, basically, puts the emergency clause...on the amendment we had before, as it, we have a period of time that it wouldn't be covered, so it puts an operative date of July 1st, 1995 on the bill, along with the emergency clause to take care of this problem. If there are any questions, I would be glad to try and answer them. Thank you.
