SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. All members not present, not in the Chamber, please return to the floor. Record your presence, the house is under call. SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Day is arriving. So we're looking for Senators Robak, McKenzie, Hartnett. Mr. Clerk.
