CLERK: Senator Maurstad, Senator, with respect to LB 752, I have E & R amendments, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 752.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 752. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.
