

SENATOR BEUTLER: I challenge the ruling of the Chair.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler. The last motion up is your motion to overrule the Chair...to challenge the Chair. It's my understanding that that...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, I would withdraw my motion to challenge the Chair.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is withdrawn. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I'll withdraw my motion to divide the question.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is withdrawn. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: At this point, Madam President, I think if we could have a few moments we could probably resolve the matter. If there are others that would like to speak on the matter, I wish they would do so. In fact, maybe the best thing to do, if there's another amendment up, I would withdraw the amendment temporarily and resubmit it.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There are other amendments, Senator, your motion is withdrawn at this time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Witek. You want it...okay, I didn't know if you were going to substitute. Withdraw completely? I have two from you, Senator.

SENATOR WITEK: I withdraw all my amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Robak, the next amendment I have, Senator, is from you. But I have a note, Senator, you want to withdraw AM1180, Senator, is that right? Withdraw.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is withdrawn.
