

this license revocation and I'm not sure that...and I know we need to do something to affect children's visitation rights, noncustodial parents' visitation of children. That's certainly a problem. And I'm not in the least bit interested in letting noncustodial parents get away without paying for child support, it's just that I'm not sure that the way we're doing it is the way we should be doing it with this legislation. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Dierks. Senator Lindsay. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President and members of the Legislature, just to briefly support the amendment. You may recall that the Day amendment really has these two aspects. One is the access to the courts aspect for people interested in having a review of their visitation, and the other aspect of it is using license revocation as a tool in that process. And now what we're doing is flushing out and strengthening the court access provisions which I think are far and away the more important aspect of the Day amendment and that will bring into play and highlight then the next amendment where you will make...where Senator Chambers will ask you to cut off the license revocation tool as it applies to visitation and simply leave the court access aspect of the amendment in place. So, for the moment, I think it makes a lot of sense to strengthen that court access aspect of the Day amendment and then look to the next question. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Madam President, members, obviously, I still have big problems with the bill but this amendment, I think, is a good amendment. It does at least recognize that there are those whose support at some time was set too high or in some cases too low. But it does recognize that fact, does allow for a procedure so that people who get so far in debt that they have no reasonable prospect of getting out of that debt have some mechanism by which they can appeal the level at which that child support is set. So I think the amendment is a...this amendment is a good amendment. I would like to though just take a second to respond. Obviously, I have no idea, I have to read the transcript to know exactly what I said but I think my comments have been mischaracterized in indicating that I think the state has gone overboard in collecting child support.
