

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, just so that it's clear for the record what it is that I'm striking, and it is written down on the amendment on the Clerk's desk, I'm dealing with Senator Day's amendment to the committee amendments which had been adopted. And on page 1 of her amendment, continuing to page 2 is a section that makes a reference to the Department of Motor Vehicles and the operator's license. Then I go to the page, as I mentioned to Senator Wehrbein, pages 8 through 11 which lay out the procedure for the revocation of these licenses and some of the factors that go into consideration of that. All that would be done by my amendment is to remove the material relative to license revocations. Everything else about access to the courts for those who are having problems with their visitation would still be in place. This aspect of an attempt to enforce would be taken out. Because we are so few in number, I will, at this point, ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, please return to your seats, check in. Unauthorized parties leave the floor. Senators, please return to your seats and check in. Senator Lindsay, will you please check in. Senator Matzke, Senator Pirsch. Please, Senator Lindsay. Senator Cudaback, Senator Stuhr, Senator Witek, Senator Hudkins, Senator Janssen, Senator Landis. Senator Hudkins, Senator Witek, Senator Landis. Senator Chambers, we're...evidently it's been reported that Senator Witek has been...is not available. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The...there's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1814-15 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 14 nays.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is not adopted. Call is raised. Anything else on the committee amendment?

CLERK: Senator Lindsay would move to amend.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Lindsay.
