SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Withem. Mr. Clerk, we'll go to LB 889.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 889, Senator Maurstad, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 889.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 889. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to advance LB 889 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 889 to E & R Engrossing. For discussion on LB 889, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I'd like to ask Senator Wehrbein a question.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Wehrbein, will you yield for a question?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Wehrbein, what is the amount that is being requested in this bill? I haven't turned to it in my book yet.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It's the spending authority of \$750,000 to take us from now till the 30th of June.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what...oh, is this the one we talked about on the temporary employees?
