SENATOR WEHRBEIN: June 30.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So by between now and June 30, you're going to have \$5 million.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what is to be done with that \$5 million?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That is proposed to be reappropriated in the next year and go into the Cash Reserve Fund.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And if you don't have \$5 million, can I ridicule and taunt you all?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Can I scoff at you?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, any reasonable man can do anything he wants.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Can I say you all were snookered?
