LB 309, 530, 598, 774

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I would move to advance LB 309 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 598.

CLERK: LB 598, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I'd move to advance LB 598 to E & R final.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 739. Okay, 739 has an amendment. We'll deal with that tomorrow. LB 774.

CLERK: LB 774, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I'd move to advance LB 774 to E & R final.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. We'll leave consent calendar, go on to General File. First bill up from Senator Lynch is LB 530. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 530 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Lynch, Coordsen, Janssen, Vrtiska and Wehrbein and Cudaback. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 18 of this year. It was referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.
