

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Jensen, your light is next on the committee amendments.

SENATOR JENSEN: Mr. President, members of the body, I have some questions. Senator Robinson, would you respond, please?

SENATOR HALL: Senator Robinson, would you respond, please.

SENATOR JENSEN: Oh, you ready?

SENATOR ROBINSON: I'm here.

SENATOR JENSEN: Good. Exempted from this bill is the University of Nebraska, the state colleges, Department of Aeronautics, Department of Roads and the Board of Educational Lands and Funds. I believe that is correct. Is that your understanding?

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah. Where are you getting that from?

SENATOR JENSEN: Pardon? I'm on page 7. On lines...

SENATOR ROBINSON: Yeah, I see it, okay. That's right, go ahead.

SENATOR JENSEN: ...1 and 6, okay. So those particular entities are exempt.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Right.

SENATOR JENSEN: And Senator Maurstad had a question there that brought to my mind several things in regards to Game and Parks. Back on Section 5, line 24, evidently then DAS is going to take over not only the maintenance and custodial duties, but also the security. In other words, the police powers, so to speak, of the Game and Parks. Is that correct?

SENATOR ROBINSON: That's correct.

SENATOR JENSEN: And also all the buildings and land that Game and Parks does have. How many persons are going to be required or going to need to be hired to provide these functions? Is there anything determined on that?

SENATOR ROBINSON: No, we...I have no information on that.
