

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And if those conditions are not met, if information is given to the federal government to get this money and after the money comes here it is not used in accord with the program requirements, won't that money have to go back?

SENATOR ROBINSON: I don't think in the case of Maximus it does.

SENATOR HALL: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: On what do you base that?

SENATOR ROBINSON: Just what I've heard about the Maximus bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And Maximus told...

SENATOR ROBINSON: It can go into the General Fund. It doesn't necessarily have to go back to that specific program.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did Maximus tell you that?

SENATOR ROBINSON: That's what I've heard in different meetings.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now if they are mistaken, well, there's not enough time, but I just like to raise these questions to kind of pique your interest.

SENATOR ROBINSON: We're getting revved up, aren't we?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, but what you really did, Senator Robinson, you did explain that part about the Game and Parks buildings and I really did not understand that clearly, but I do now. Thank you.
