

estimate that 530 anticipates a transfer of department public institutions and an engineering division and Lincoln Regional Center maintenance functions for 1995 to '97 only, and there will be no net fiscal impact, no bureaucracies or kingdoms being developed with this. A better use of the very competent professional staff we already have on board. I appreciate all the comments that have been made and the concerns we'll address on Select File, and I ask for your support for the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Lynch. The question before you is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 530. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The committee amendments are adopted. Is there anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: We will return to a discussion. I raise the call. Senator Lynch, to open on the bill.

SENATOR LYNCH: Madam Speaker and members, I think it's been thoroughly discussed. The amendment is the bill. The two bills were consolidated and I think we've discussed it thoroughly. I do make the commitment, I am sure the committee agrees and Senator Robinson also, that we intend to talk with the agencies who are concerned about this before Select, long before Select, and answer any questions that you might have. Please come to us if you do because we certainly want those concerns satisfied. And I would appreciate very much your advancing LB 530 to E & R Initial.
