But I would rather they make both of them singular than make both of them plural because then you would be saying Game and Park, meaning park the "s" someplace else. All these little things might help us keep it in mind. Game and Parks. I'm not going to do that for the full five minutes, but I hope I've sufficiently called attention to it so that if any of our colleagues do say Games and Parks, we'll greet it with a round of good-humored laughter because sometimes things are achieved through laughter which are not done by means of the pedagogical approach that I've taken this morning. But, in conclusion, it's Game and Parks. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Madam Chairman and members, just a couple things I would like to say. This will not affect the gifts, as many people are worried about here. This will not affect the gift situation. It's only to bring in accountability to such if it costs more to receive a gift than you're going to get from the gift, then you better look at it. It will not affect employees. That's addressed. It treats it like a business. It treats the situation as a business which most people want to see. And another important issue I would like to bring up right now, is the fact...and stress this will not take place overnight. This will not happen overnight. I mean, you don't change a ship on a...the direction of a ship on a dime, you know, it takes a long time to do it. This will take a long time coming. DAS does not want to do this next year or the next year, it will take several years to implement this whole idea. They cannot do it immediately. It's a good bill. It's a bill for the people and I think we all can see through it now and I thank you all for your questions. We need to question the situation where it involves taxpayers' dollars and there are many dollars involved in this situation and so thank you for your time and consideration and I hope you support the bill.
