SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Madam President. I will be very brief and if I can indulge the members so we can move quickly through this. This amendment is simply a conforming amendment so that the bill will conform to LB 94, a bill introduced by Senator Bromm and signed by the Governor on March 1. The only reason it has to be in here is that LB 99 opened up the same section as LB 94 and since 94 is already passed we have to conform 99 so, hopefully, if it passes, they will go together. It probably could have been an E & R amendment but if you'll indulge me, we will take care of it now. Thank you.
