

Warner amendment to LB 499. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Warner amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 499 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the advancement of LB 499. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 499 advances. We'll pass over LB 856 and move to LB 805.

CLERK: LB 805, Madam President, Senator, no E & R. Senator Pedersen would move to amend the bill. (Pedersen amendment, AM1794, appears on pages 1865-66 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Pedersen.

SENATOR PEDERSEN: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this amendment is an amendment that for cities the size of Omaha would have two members from within their zoning jurisdiction...on their planning board of seven members, two of them would be appointed that live within the three mile zoning jurisdiction. District 39, my district, has been growing by 2,200 homes a year. Most of my district is within the three mile zoning jurisdiction of Omaha, and this amendment takes my bill, LB 575, turns it into an amendment and adds it into a bill, 805, which it's very germane to. These members...there's one member now in that zoning jurisdiction on the board appointed by the mayor. That member would stay there but he would lose his...he or she would lose their voting privileges on anything that happened within the city, they only vote on things that happen within the three mile zoning jurisdiction and it would make another member do that same. And this would happen through attrition, as they lose a member then they would appoint another member, or the mayor would appoint another member. If there's any question about that, I'd be glad to answer them. Thank you.
