CLERK: E & R amendments, first of all, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 699.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 699. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Brashear would move to amend with AM1808. (Amendment may be found on page 1867 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Brashear to open on his amendment.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Madam President, members of the body, during the course of the enrollment and review process it was determined that we also need to make a similar deletion by striking, at Section 48-523 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes, the words "and mail a copy of such record to the commissioner of labor as prescribed in Section 48-508", which happens to be the section from which we're deleting that same requirement. This is a technical change only, doesn't change at all the legislation, and would urge that the amendment be adopted.
