PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator McKenzie. Is there any discussion of the McKenzie amendment? Seeing none, Senator McKenzie, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the McKenzie amendment to the committee amendments to LB 629. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator McKenzie's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The McKenzie amendment is adopted. We return to a discussion of the committee amendments. Is there any further discussion of the committee amendments? Senator Bromm, do you wish to close on the committee amendments? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 629. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The committee amendments are adopted. Chair recognizes Senator McKenzie to open on LB 629. Waives opening. Is there any discussion on the advancement of LB 629? Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: How much time is left on the bill?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Seven and a half minutes, Senator.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator McKenzie, if you were going to open on the bill, what would you have said?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Senator Bernard-Stevens, I believe I would have said we have explained the bill in the amendment to the committee amendments, and if anyone had questions following the last vote on the committee amendments with no discussion, I would have been happy to address those.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Senator McKenzie. With that explanation, it certainly has brought me onto the bill, and
