PRESIDENT ROBAK: ...the question is, shall LB 489 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1877 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 40 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting.
