

school districts if it is a loan program and not a grant program. And the remaining money, besides the \$4 million, is the money that is currently loaned out by the weatherization program and would continue as a weatherization program. So I offer that to you by way of compromise. I think it is a reasonable compromise. I hope you can support it. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to the Robinson amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the Beutler amendment to the Robinson amendment, have you all voted? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Crosby, I'd just ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SENATOR CROSBY: There is a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
