SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Senator Maurstad. Chair recognizes Senator Hall. Is there anybody else wishing to speak on LR 99? If not, we'll go to a vote on adoption of LR 99. Those in favor indicate by voting aye, those opposed.... Clerk, record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of LR 99.

SENATOR WESELY: LR 99 is adopted. On a point of personal privilege, I'd like to recognize first Senator LaVon Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Because I know you're all anxious to leave I want to wish you all a happy Arbor Day weekend. And I'm helping you celebrate that by delivering the annual tree to your office which we hope you plant this weekend. The little card that comes with it, I always like the last line because I think...these trees come to us from the Nebraska Forestry Service at the University of Nebraska Lincoln, and what it says at the end is, "Plant it for Nebraskans yet unborn as a symbol of your faith and confidence in what Nebraska will be for them."
