PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is so ordered.

CLERK: Senator Day would move to amend the committee amendments, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Day to open on her amendment.

SENATOR DAY: Thank you, Madam President and colleagues. This amendment is being passed out to you now. It comes from a discussion that we had when we last talked about this bill that there was some concern that a license could be pulled by mistake and that individual would still have to pay the reinstatement fee. All this does is put into the legislation, if that should happen that the renewal fee that was incurred would be returned to the person. I still am of the firm belief we have enough due process in there that this won't happen, but again this was a concern that I heard from Senator Chambers and some others so hopefully this will address that concern. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Day. Is there any discussion of the Day amendment? Seeing none, Senator Day, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Day amendment to the committee amendments to LB 592. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Day's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Day amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments at this time, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any further discussion on the committee amendments? Senator Day.

SENATOR DAY: Thank you, Madam President and colleagues. I just want to review with you where we're at on this and maybe address some of the questions and concerns that came up on our last discussion. What we have here is licensed revocation for nonpayment of child support. It takes three months before any notice is sent or that it kicks out three months in arrears,
