SENATOR DAY: But you're talking about two different things here.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENSON: Okay.

SENATOR DAY: I mean you're talking about if I can't pay the child support because my situation is changed, I'm not going to talk about being three months in arrears or anything like that. All right, that's when I go to the referee and that has to be court ordered. Now if I'm three months in arrears...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Time. Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Vrtiska. Excuse me, Senator Chambers, your light is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I want to ask Senator Day a question. And, Senator Day, this goes to the side about the license revocation but before trying to get rid of all of that in one fell swoop, I would like you to turn to page 11 of AM1026 which I think is the part of the committee amendment which says strike the original sections, so you're...okay. In line 5, I want to add an amendment after dollars, but I'll read what is in lines 2-5. Upon presentation by the license holder of a written confirmation of compliance, to the Department of Motor Vehicles, the license holder may have his or her operator's license reinstated upon payment of a fee of \$95. What I would like to insert after dollars is something to the effect that such fee shall be waived if an operator's license was suspended because of mistake or lack of legal justification.

SENATOR DAY: Senator Chambers, I heard you when you brought that argument up before and we've already adopted an amendment that will do that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, you did?

SENATOR DAY: Yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: In this...

SENATOR DAY: Yes. It should be on your desk.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, thank you.
