

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yeah.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...from the revocation of such license.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yeah, and the intent there is to the extent that it is in the bill. I don't know if liability is even addressed in the bill, and that's...but to the extent that that is done. If we want to amend it, I don't have any problem with that, but, and as long as that is a policy decision made too by the body. If the revocation takes place, maybe it is one that ought to be considered, but the intent of it is to make clear that the licensing authority doesn't, so if we need to amend it, I don't have a problem doing that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Well, to that extent, Senator, I would hope you withdraw it and perhaps reassert it on Select File because, as you are well aware, making the authorized attorney or the person conducting the initial hearing liable is totally impractical, is not in accordance with what we do on all other judicial forums.

SENATOR LINDSAY: We are not in a judicial forum, though, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, an administrative hearing forum. Do you know of any other administrating hearing officer who has ever been made liable for?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Oh, that is not...that is not the intention here at all, and I don't think that says that. It is referring to the person requesting the certification, not...well, and I guess it is ambiguous to that extent. And that's, like I say, the intent, the thrust is the relevant licensing authority. It is not intended to have any liability on the administrative hearing officer at all, and I can see where you could read that, that the certification...it's intent, if there is going to be any liability and it is not intended to create that, but to the extent that it may exist, if there is going to be any liability, it should be on whoever is doing the pursuing of the action, rather than on a licensing authority that must act once it is given the certification, and that's the thrust of it. So it...yeah, maybe it needs to be redrafted, but it's a concern, and maybe I will withdraw it, but I'll at least see where, if the body is not...doesn't have any interest in the issue, I am not going to go through the time of redrafting it and taking up
