SENATOR LINDSAY: Senator Chambers, I am an attorney. It is not ethical for me to speak succinctly. (Laughter) The thrust is that we are going to, and I don't think we ought to kid ourselves, we are going to have some people who are going to have their licenses suspended when they were not delinquent, and that is, as I mentioned just in Lancaster County, there were 139, I guess, that at least that made the paper, actually 140 as there is another one mentioned in the article, that in Lancaster County that we found that they are not...had their licenses or had their child support determined to be delinquent when it wasn't. So the question that we have then is if that is a person who is...who drives a truck for a dairy and delivers milk, or a person who is an over-the-road trucker, or a person who is a...oh, I hit a...I think I hit something there with Senator Witek, or a person who is a surgeon, or someone who is going to have that license, driver's or professional license revoked. What happens to that person who loses that couple of thousand dollar contract to haul or that surgeon who has to cancel a couple of days of surgeries in order to get... because can't do it without the license, or some of those types of things where it was revoked and should not have been, those people are hurting. They have been hurt by the actions of someone, and what I want to make clear, what I am trying to make clear is the person who should not be liable is that person who is simply complying with this law, which is you shall revoke it if this certification is received.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right.

SENATOR LINDSAY: That's what I am trying to do, and it may not be drafted that way, but that is what I am trying to get to.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And with what Senator Lindsay has said, I support what he is trying to do. Remember this, we have a set of circumstance where an individual whose license is to be revoked has come to the attention of this person who is to be made liable under Senator Lindsay's amendment, whatever form it ultimately takes. What it really is doing, Senator Lindsay's amendment, that is, is holding up a caution sign, and it is saying...
