

going to ask for a call of the house now, and then I will go ahead and speak.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Members in the Chamber, please take their seats, record your presence. Unauthorized parties leave the floor. Senator Lindsay, you have about four and a half minutes of your closing.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker and members, again, just to repeat what the amendment does, and the amendment is on your desk. The amendment simply makes the policy decision of who will bear the brunt of a wrongfully taken license. We know, I think we can fairly say there will be some license taken wrongfully. The evidence is out there of the records being inaccurate in Lancaster County, or at least at the time of that publication they were. The evidence is out there that the Clerk of the District Court in Douglas County says his records are inaccurate, and I should make it clear, not because of their fault, because of a system that has holes in it. It is not because of the clerk's fault, they both do their jobs very well, but because of a system that has holes in it, those records don't reflect what the actual state of affairs is. So the question then becomes is...the question becomes if we wrongfully take that license of the guy who is out there selling insurance, and we take his license so he can't sell insurance, even though he was never delinquent, or we take that trucker's license, and that trucker is on an over-the-road, a long over-the-road trip when that 30 day notice comes, and by the way, you don't get three months, you get 30 days. I had that question asked of me a couple of times of the three months notice. You do not get three months notice, you get 30 days notice. What they say is you can't send that notice out until you are three months delinquent on the court records, meaning those couples, or ex-couples, who are still amicable, pay the support directly because it cuts a couple of weeks off the time that it takes to get that check, and then receipt for it every year, or every few months, that three-month period is running. So they get 30 days notice. Now that trucker is on that over-the-road haul
