There isn't any law that we can pass that will make human beings get along the way we'd like them all to get along, and the way they should get along. It won't happen. But we do have to remember, and that's why I worry and I am very concerned about doing some more things here that may just make it...some of the parents, on both sides, both of the par...some of the parents use the children as a weapon. And when we give them more ammunition, then we have...we create another problem. That's why I want to be really sure that this bill is a really good bill that is going to work when it comes to Final Reading. Thank you.
