

this exemption. But, I mean, I guess in good conscience you have to say that this amendment is one that ought to be adopted to clarify what the issue is all about that is embodied in LB 106. As much as I'd like to oppose it, I rise in support of the amendment. I think it just clearly does nothing more than say here's where in this area the definition we're going to spell out what veterinary medicines are and it means that they are medicines for the prevention or treatment of disease of injury to animals, I think is another good amendment if that one is to follow. With that I rise in support of the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. Senator Chambers, would you engage me a little bit in dialogue again?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Certainly, I will.

SENATOR DIERKS: The reason that I suggested we work on this for Select File amendment was not only to expedite the passage of this bill but to provide some time for other people who have bills on General File that would like to address them and I just thought it might help us to do this for a Select File amendment, we could do it all in one fell swoop and wouldn't have to take the time of the body working this word and that word or the next word, that we could do it all at once and I understand you don't like the bill and you're going to try to keep doing anything to keep it from passing. I do like the bill and I think I have got enough support to get it to pass, so all we're going through here is a stalling action that really does nobody any good I believe except maybe you and I think the rest of the body would like to see the bill move. I'd like to see the bill move and so I just ask if you wouldn't withdraw the motion, the amendment and work with me for a Select File amendment that we can all agree with. (inaudible), if you like.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, Senator Dierks, and whoever has been talking to him on this issue and some others that will come up is presumptuous in saying I'm engaged in a stalling tactic. When you all bring these poorly drafted bills I'm going to deal with them before, when they're before us and if you all get irritated, that's
