

the... it's in the issue of April 4th, '95, Nebraska Court of Appeals, but there are definitely facts in there that support the result of the case and I'm not sure that the result would have been any different with this amendment, just... just to point that out. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Seeing no further lights, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, to try to make it crystal clear what this amendment does I'm going to read the actual language of it. We would add a new section and it would say the following: Notwithstanding any provisions in Sections 43-101 to 43-117, any biological mother who has executed a relinquishment and consent to adopt shall have the right within two days of executing such relinquishment and consent to revoke such relinquishment and consent. Members of the Legislature, whose interests will be hurt or harmed by giving the mother two days? Even if there's an adoption agency out there, two days they can wait. If the attending physician has brokered the adoption, two days he can wait. If a lawyer has been involved, he can wait two days, or she. So all I'm asking is that we consider the fact that after a woman has actually given birth, given some time to think about the relationship between herself and this newborn child, she may want to change her mind and keep the child and those who say they believe in family values should not say that we're going to fracture this relationship for all time and never give the young woman a chance to reconsider her decision. What I'm asking is that we give that opportunity and, Madam President, while I finish, I'm going to ask for a call of the house, because I'll have to anyway.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
